Meeting Minutes



Meeting notes for July 7th, 2022.

David Flett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited and observed. Seventeen members were in attendance.

The first order of business was the treasurer's report from Michael Zink. As of July 7th there was \$6,341.36 in the kitty.

The 40th Annual Lubbock Mustang Car Club Show was considered a success. We had 84 cars registered in the show. Registrants were happy to receive 2 door prizes and were satisfied with the judges and the judged results.

Ed Cooper presented information on feather flags. Feather flags are often seen in front of businesses and usually range from 8 to 12 feet tall. They hang along the length of a pole and have a company logo or something of promotion printed on them. The suggestion would be to have our logo on one side and the words "Car Show" printed on the other side. Feather flags would help advertise our car shows at their locations. A flag standing 12 feet tall is recommended with prices ranging from roughly \$240 to \$490, depending on the vendor. Those prices include flag, flag pole, ground base and travel bag. Bring your ideas to the next meeting on August 4th and we'll put it to a vote!

Don't forget the VFW fish fry. The event occurs on the second Friday evening of each month. Attendees are asked to meet at the north side of the Kohl's parking lot at 98th and Indiana at about 5:45 pm, or so. Look for the big "Kohl's" sign on 98th, that's where the gang will be waiting. The next VFW fish fry will be on Friday, August 12th.

I believe the next "Meet and Feed" or "Mustang Feed Bag" at Buns Over Texas, will occur on Thursday, August 18, 2022. It is scheduled for 6:00 pm. Tommy Persons suggested that if y'all would like to cruise to Buns Over Texas, meet up at the north side of the Kohl's parking lot at 98th and Indiana at about 5:45 pm, or so. Then cruise up to Buns Over Texas. We'll aim for parking on the south side of the restaurant as many of the other businesses in that

immediate area will be closed for the evening by then. This will be a reoccurring event on the third Thursday evening of each month.


