Meeting notes for July 3rd, 2025.

David Flett called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited and observed. Sprague Fleming led our prayer, thank you Sprague! Twenty-one members were in attendance.

The first order of business was the treasurer's report. As of July 3rd, there was \$5,139.19 In the kitty. Not all bills from our show have been paid at this time.

The club would like to thank everyone who helped with our annual show, this includes but is not limited to Neil, Scott, Gordon, Linda, Tommy, Art, Debbie, John Flett, John Robison and others. Thanks also to those who helped with wrap-up and repack of the trailer, all went well and quickly with the extra hands.

Joe Marnell of Wayland Baptist University passed away in June. He was a great friend to the Lubbock Mustang Club and helped us use the Wayland Baptist Campus for our annual show. John Robison suggested that the club donate \$100 to Wayland in his honor. This action was put to a vote and passed.

Car registrations were down this year at our show. Much of this can be attributed to the other events scheduled for that day, the first Saturday of June can be a busy day with many events scheduled. That said, I believe our show went well. The food was great this year and we had no complaints from attendees. With that I would have to say our show was still a success.

There were 13 Mustangs at the Big Wicks event in the Drug Emporium parking lot. We had 12 Mustangs and 18 people attend our June restaurant trip to Levelland.

Six Mustangs and 8 people attended the Independence Day Parade in Spur, Texas on July 4th.

At least 2 Mustangs from our club went up to the Tulia show on July 19th. Ten Mustangs and 12 people attended the Caprock Classics car show at Lubbock Christian University on July 19th.

Our first Mustang Club Car Club Top Pick award was given away at the Caprock Classics show. It was decided that we give the award to a survivor car or something unique and primarily stock. The only main requirement, it couldn't be a Mustang but needed to be a Ford.

There were several vehicles involved in deliberation, namely an early Ford Econoline van, a 1963 Thunderbird, and a 1958 Edsel. The award was given to Richard Rice and his 1973 Gran Torino. The car showed up with a great family story of preservation and limited restoration. The engine and transmission are stock in this car, the body and interior are very straight. Seeing a Torino 50 years ago was no big deal, seeing one in that shape today was a pleasant surprise. The Econoline van is a work in progress but coming along very well. The '63 Bird was largely stock but needed a little additional body work. The hood was not open on the Edsel, we didn't know what power it had.

We have been contacted by the Post Rodeo Event planners to participate in a car show to promote the Post Rodeo. The time for this would be August 9th.

The Windmill Museum would still like to have us over for an indoor car show. We would supply the cars, they provide everything else, a good summer or winter car show event.

Tim Carmicheal gave the car story this month. Someone will need to "pony up" next month with another good car story.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 pm. It was another busy meeting this month. Our next meeting will be on Thursday, August 7th. As always, keep the shiny side up and the rubber side down.
