Gary was a veteran, serving in the U.S. Navy. He and his service was honored with a brick at the Lubbock Veteran's Memorial at 84<sup>th</sup> Street and Nashville on Veteran's Day, just a few weeks ago. Gary was one of the founding members of the Lubbock Mustang Club. Gary started the HORSE game. The club he helped to start has lasted nearly 40 years and is most likely the oldest Mustang car club in the country.

Back in 1964 Gary worked at the parts department of the Ford dealership in Decatur, Illinois. After seeing the newly introduced Mustang in the showroom at work everyday, he finally ordered his in August of 1964, a Tropical Turquoise coupe with black interior and 289 V8. The "Stang" helped move Gary and Jill around the United States before making their final move to Lubbock in 1983. In April of that year they attended the first meeting of the Lubbock Mustang Club. A meeting organized by Hugh Armstrong. Gary always kept his Mustang in great condition. Upon Gary's death in March of 2021, the Mustang was awarded to Gary and Jill's nephew in Pennsylvania. The car remains well maintained as their nephew is another big Mustang enthusiast.
