Several toys from the Christmas Party donations were donated to a janitorial employee at Hillcrest Country Club the night of the party. This donation was cleared by officers of the club. There will be more discussion on this topic at the next meeting so bring your ideas next month! Planning for the 2024 Lubbock Mustang Club Car Show has begun. The show is scheduled to be on Saturday, June 8th, 2024. Preparation for the car show is a team effort and that is always greatly appreciated by everyone!

Another subject that came up at the meeting was the idea of developing a roster of club members. The other idea was to organize before going to any car shows we would like to attend. To that end, we could then park together at the show.

This month's car story comes out of the January edition of Mustang Times. Andrew Hack of Wisconsin was looking for a 1971 Mustang and found one in California. It was a one owner car, a woman who used it as a daily driver for 28 years before she decided to sell it in

1999. Although the car was used as a daily driver, it was well maintained and driven carefully. Andrew bought the car and upon closer inspection, found it a little odd that it came with all the “Boss 302” stuff, 4-speed with Hurst shifter, dual exhaust, 9-inch rear and black-out hood, except for its two-barrel 351. Intrigued by this, Andrew ordered a Marti report on the car. Several months later, Andrew received a call from Kevin Marti. Kevin told Andrew that his 351 two-barrel car started life as the only 1971 Boss 302 ever produced. Ford had decided to pull out of racing activities and focus on the dreaded “emissions and fuel economy approach”. With that the Boss 302 engine was cancelled, but not before one car left the factory in August of 1970. Later the car was reinvoiced, and re-badged, as Mach 1 with a Boss 351 engine. Andrew kept and maintained the car for over 10 years before selling it to Boss collector and restorer Bob Perkins. Bob restored the car to original 1971 Boss 302 specifications, it’s Boss 302 crate engine purchased from a former Ford Cleveland engine plant employee. Bob now has the only 1971 Boss 302 ever produced. For more information about this car, check out the January 2024 edition of Mustang times. The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 pm. It was another busy meeting this month. Keep the shiny side up and the rubber side down. We’ll see y’all next month, on February 1st, 7:00 pm at RedZone Cafe!
