RETURN OF THE KING

Shelby American has introduced a third generation of the legendary Shelby GT500KR. Based on Ford's 760-horse Shelby GT500, the new post-title KR pushes horsepower to over 900 and comes with forged wheels, upgraded suspension, carbon fiber body components, and updated interior. Extremely limited, only 60 GT500KRs will be built per model year for the U.S. for a total of 180 units. A limited number will be built outside of the U.S. by authorized mod shops. All 2022 model year GT500KRs will receive 60th anniversary badging.

Shelby American will start taking orders for the Shelby GT500KR on February 1, with production beginning in the first quarter of 2022. As a post-title vehicle, owners of 2020 and 2021 Shelby GT500s can contact Shelby American about transforming their car into a KR. Orders for 2022 cars are being accepted as well; they will wear 60th anniversary badges.

This is only the third time in history that a version of the Shelby GT500 has carried the "King of the Road" name, starting in 1968 when the GT500KR was powered by the new 335-horsepower 428 Cobra Jet. For 2008-09, the GT500KR returned with 540 supercharged horsepower, 3.73:1 rear axle, unique wheels, and upgraded suspension. A special composite hood with push button hood pins, unique stripes, and badges distinguished the KR. A total of 1,000 were produced in 2008 along with an additional 712 for 2009.
