Discussion over the artwork for this year's car show t-shirts and show flyers continued at this meeting. We are getting closer to a final design which should be available for the March meeting. The idea is to get flyers ready for the Cars and Coffee shows in March. The show is scheduled to be on Saturday, June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

Dennis gave the report from Mustang Club of America. Mustang Club of America (MCA) is looking for more articles and photos about regional club car shows. Of particular interest to them is "National Mustang Day" on April 17<sup>th</sup>. The "National Mustang Day" LMC car show is scheduled for Saturday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> at Pollard Ford. Cling decals are available from MCA to promote the event. The cling decals are going for \$1.50 each. It was decided that the club will order roughly 75 of these cling decals. One cling decal will be supplied to each member as their dues are paid. If anyone would like another cling decal, each extra one will be available for \$1.50 each. The cling decals are designed to be displayed on a window, windshield. We can report our show to the National Mustang Museum and maybe we'll get an article in the MCA publication "Mustang Times".
