Meeting Minutes –

Meeting notes for August 7th, 2025.

David Flett called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited and observed. Sprague Fleming led our prayer, thank you Sprague! Thirty members were in attendance; we were just a few seats shy of filling up the Banquet Room. Several new members came to the meeting, Darren Berkley with his 2009 GT, Shane Robinson with his 1966 Fastback and Christian Vaughan with his 2004 GT; welcome to the herd!

The first order of business was the treasurer's report. As of August 7th, there was \$5,101.59 In the kitty. We're in pretty good shape!

Six Mustangs and 8 people attended the Independence Day Parade in Spur, Texas on July 4th.

We received several thank you letters for our attendance to several events in July. We received a letter of appreciation from the City of Spur Chamber of Commerce and two copies of the town newspaper. This was a fun event and I hope to participate next year. We also received a thank you letter and painted American Flag gift from Lakeridge Assisted Living for attending their show. Finally, we received a thank you letter from Wayland Baptist University concerning our gift to the college in the memory of Joe Marnell.

At least 2 Mustangs from our club went up to the Tulia show on July 19th. Ten Mustangs and 12 people attended the Caprock Classics car show at Lubbock Christian University on July 19th.

Our first Mustang Club Car Club Top Pick award was given away at the Caprock Classics show. It was decided that we give the award to a survivor car or something unique and primarily stock. The only main requirement, it couldn't be a Mustang but needed to be a Ford. There were several vehicles involved in deliberation, namely an early Ford Econoline van, a 1963 Thunderbird, and a 1958 Edsel. The award was given to Richard Rice and his 1973 Gran Torino. The car showed up with a great family story of preservation and limited restoration. The engine and transmission are stock in this car, the body and interior are very straight. Seeing a Torino 50 years ago was no big deal, seeing one in that shape today was a pleasant surprise. The Econoline van is a work in progress but coming along very well. The '63 Bird was largely stock but needed a little additional body work. The hood was not open on the Edsel, we didn't

know what power it had.

The Post Rodeo car show event has been canceled planners to participate in a car show to promote the Post Rodeo. The Post Rodeo is still going and will be happening on August 9th.

The Watermelon Festival in Plains, TX will be on Saturday, August 30th. Check your email to see where we'll meet up to convoy over there!

The Roadrunners Car Club show in Hobbs, NM will be on September 20th. The band "Foghat" will be there so join us to be there and yell "Slow Ride"!

The Windmill Museum would still like to have us over for an indoor car show. We would supply the cars, they provide everything else, a good late summer or winter car show event.

John Flett gave us a car care announcement. If you have a 2018 or newer vehicle, you may want to stop by your local dealership parts department to run your VIN number to see what battery your car had installed from the factory. The reason for this is that some vehicles received an AGM battery from the factory. This is important to know since if the AGM battery is replaced with a conventional battery the alternator and new battery will be ruined. New computers don't like old style batteries. Just one more thing in our "Computer Age" we have to be careful about.

The car story this month came from Todd. When I was a kid there was a guy with a 1969 428 Cobra Jet in our neighborhood. It was Raven Black with the Shaker hood scoop, even the anti-hop bars on the back axle were painted black! All the normal chrome trim was on this car including a set of Crager wheels. I would only see this car early on Saturday mornings, the driver would just idle through the neighborhood. It was a bad machine, a muffled rumble as it idled down the street. Those mornings I would be on my bike, and every time I would see this car I would stop and watch. The driver would smile and give a little wave from the top of the steering wheel. Seeing that car 30 + years ago is a big reason why I own a Mustang today!

Here are the details on my straight six I would like to have listed to our fellow club members. The engine is a 68 block that puts out black smoke when cold but smooths out after it heats up. It has a new improved exhaust manifold and a new single barrel carb. There is one manifold bolt that has stripped but there is no evidence of leaking. The intake manifold is original but it does cause vapor lock in the summertime thanks to its location. Over the last 5 years of driving it, it has not given me any problems or concerns. The oil pan may need to be replaced as the previous owner beat it up. It still holds oil but appearance wise it is not nice. Do note the alternator, AC pump, oil cap and air cleaner will not be included. I am asking \$300 for it, but I am open to reasonable offers. Delivery not available. 
